What is Kansas Clean Sweep?

It is a waste pesticide collection program sponsored by your Kansas Department of Health and Environment. The goal is to remove unwanted pesticides from Kansas farms and ranches.

How do you participate?

The dates and places are listed on the front of this brochure.

What is eligible?

Any current, canceled, unwanted, unused, obsolete, or damaged pesticide is eligible for the program. Although any pesticide will be accepted, it is important for farmers and ranchers to search their property storage areas for canceled products. The continued use of some canceled products may be illegal. The table at the right lists some canceled products which were commonly used in Kansas. If you have any of these, or any other pesticide in need of disposal, please do so now.

Empty pesticide containers will not be accepted.

Some pesticides in need of disposal:

Obsolete pesticides and other pesticides also accepted.

(Continued use of some canceled pesticides may be illegal. Act now for proper disposal. No questions will be asked.)

Who is eligible?

Any farmer or rancher who operates in Kansas is eligible for the program and does not need to pre-register.

Pesticide dealers, manufacturers, or distributors with Kansas Small Quantity Generator status or non-generators can dispose of waste pesticides for a fee per pound and must provide payment on site.
