

## Notice Publicizing the Map Information Service for Hancock County

**Notice To:** Lending Institutions, Real Estate Agents, and Insurance Agents

**Subject:** Flood Insurance Rate Map Zone Information

As a public service, the Hancock County Surveyor's Office will provide you with the following information upon request:

- 1) Whether a property is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) of the County.
- 2) Additional flood insurance data for a site, such as the FIRM zone and the base flood elevation or depth, if shown on the FIRM.
- 3) We have a handout on the flood insurance purchase requirement that can help people who need a mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- 4) Access to elevation certificates that have been processed in the County.
- 5) We have 2 Certified Floodplain Manager's on staff that can assist with questions on floodway and floodplain issues.
- 6) We have copies of Letters of Map Amendments (LOMA) or Letter of Map Revisions (LOMR) on file in our office.

If you would like to make an inquiry, please tell us the address and, if available, the subdivision, lot and block number. We are open 8:00am to 4:00pm, Monday to Friday.
